**EL PORVENIR SAYS "THANK YOU, CHURCH OF THE MASTER!"** According to Jenna Saldana, Director of U.S. Operations for El Porvenir, the nationwide online campaign to raise \$41,550 for El Porvenir (half from donors, half from One Days Wages) was a huge success, with much of the credit going to Church of the Master and donors from Westerville. In fact, the campaign goal was exceeded by almost \$5,000! The funds that were raised will be used to build a piped water system with household taps and 32

double pit latrines in Nicaragua. These projects will benefit the 319 residents of the villages of El Llano and San Agustin--and more! Jenna was very excited about a pending clean-water project in another village that can now begin, thanks to the extra dollars that were raised. THANK YOU!
